I really appreciate our volunteer printer. The quality of print is always great! Mahalo Bridget, I missed you.

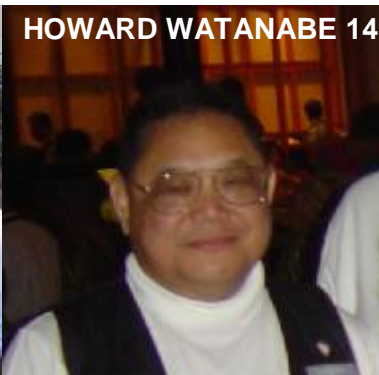

Labor Day trip to Hilo:

Plans for our Labor Day trip to the Big Island have already been in the works. Gordon Pang has volunteered to take on the task of all the logistics for the trip. Right now we are still working on a tentative cost per person.

This will include shipping of bikes 4 bikes per container, rooms for Hilo and Kona, chase van, refreshments, and gas. Other charges will be factored in later. This is just to give you some idea of approximate cost.

There has been a lot of interest in the trip so far. Printing of shirts for the trip will be discussed at a later date.

Remember we ship all bikes back to Honolulu on Tuesday Sept. 4 you must be there to load your own bike or make arraignments with another member to be responsible for getting your bike to the docks and into the containers.

**BY PROXY BY PROXY:
Let your voice be heard!**

Beginning with our first General Membership meeting, we have incorporated the use of the proxy vote.

If you know you will not be able to attend a scheduled club meeting, a proxy vote will be available to you. With this form you will have the opportunity to select anyone from the club to vote on your behalf or you may decide to give your vote to the Board or one of the Board members.

This proxy vote is very important for you to stay involved in the decision making of the club and give your voice to these decisions.

Pick someone whom you feel has the same mind set as you as far as how the club should operate. This will almost guarantee your vote will be as you wish. Call a Board member before the meeting to find out if any new proposals are set on the agenda for the meeting. You can then discuss this with your proxy vote and tell them how you wish to vote.

Elections are very important. Other than the incumbents, you will not be able to know who was nominated from the floor. You will just have to trust your proxy vote.

Either way it will be a good thing and the conclusion will be MAJORITY RULES.

If you get a message about our next meeting, and you are unable to attend, let your voice be heard and get a proxy ballot.

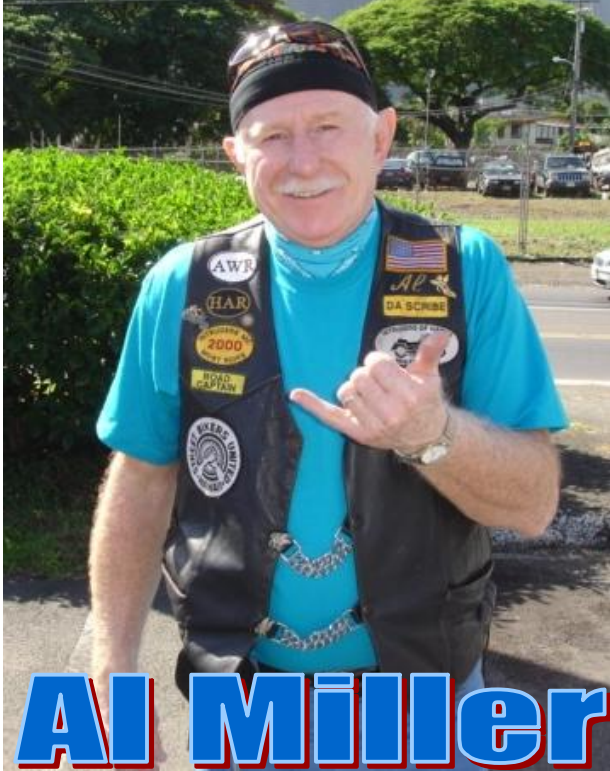
